



# SMART *Goal Worksheet*

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*Goal* : \_\_Have students understand the relevancy of math in everyday life. \_\_\_\_\_

*SPECIFIC*: *What exactly will you accomplish? ( Who what, when why, how)* \_\_Enable students to see math as a relevant subject.

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*MEASURABLE*: *How will you know when you have reached this goal? (How can you measure progress?)* \_When students make comments about how math relates to the real world.

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*ACHIEVABLE*: *Is achieving this goal realistic with effort and commitment? (What resources will you need? What skills will you need? What else will help you reach this goal?)* \_This is almost unrealistic, but hopefully some of the students can realize this goal.

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*RELEVANT*: *Why is this goal significant in your life? (Why is this goal important to you? How will this goal help your life?)* \_If they understand why we are teaching them math and they make it relevant, then they will be better math students.

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*TIMELY*: *When will this goal be accomplished? (What is your deadline?)* When will you evaluate your progress (specific dates)? \_By the time these students graduate from High School.
